- DOE selected the proposal from EIPC to develop an Eastern-interconnection-wide planning process for award under FOA-65
- Contract negotiations are underway with DOE
- The EIPC is coordinating with the Eastern Interconnection States Planning Council (EISPC)
- EIPC is continuing its stakeholder outreach activities to obtain input regarding the formation of the Stakeholder Steering Committee
