## Participation and Process

# Participation:

- Broad cross-section of stakeholders and interests
  - State and federal agencies, state legislators, electric industry reps., business and consumer organizations, efficiency and environmental organizations, regional organizations
- Active stakeholder involvement
  - On average one meeting per month
  - Notice at least two weeks prior
  - Materials posted on ISO Web site
- Commitment to attend each meeting

# Process:

- Share information, gain common understanding of issues
- Facilitate discussion
- Iterative
  - Sessions and information builds on itself
- Use of ISO Web site to share materials

# Stakeholder Responsibilities and Schedule

- **Today**
  - Hear about long-term environmental requirements
  - Identify five draft scenarios
  - Begin discussion of metrics to evaluate scenarios
- **December**
  - Review information on requirements for renewable power
  - Finalize:
    - Five Scenarios
      - Assumptions and other inputs
    - Metrics
  - Identify draft sensitivity analysis for the five basic scenarios
- **January**
  - Review long-term natural gas supply issues
  - Discuss preliminary results for the five basic scenarios
  - Review sensitivity analysis and identify any need for further simulation results

# Schedule (continued)

- February - April
  - Discuss various technologies and sources of fuel
    - Demand side management
    - Nuclear
    - Wind and other renewable resources
    - Clean coal technologies
  - Review long-term transmission issues
  - Review final simulation results
  - Identify and discuss preliminary findings
  - Review and discuss final draft findings
- May
  - Review final summary findings and draft report
