On October 4, 2012, partial Non-Price Retirement Requests were submitted for the resources identified in the table below, for the effective date of June 1, 2016.

ISO New England Inc. (“ISO-NE”) has reviewed these requests pursuant to ISO-NE Planning Procedure No. 10 – *Planning Procedure to Support the Forward Capacity Market* (“PP-10”) and has determined that there is not a reliability need for the portions of the resources seeking to retire and accordingly the partial Non-Price Retirement Requests are accepted.

As required in PP-10, this finding was reviewed with the Reliability Committee on December 18, 2012 where the need for these resources was discussed. Additionally, ISO-NE received advisory votes supporting the finding that there is not a reliability need for those portions of resources seeking to retire more than 5 MW of capacity.

Pursuant to Section III.13.2.5.2.5.3 of the ISO-NE Transmission, Markets and Service Tariff (“ISO Tariff”), the capacity of these resources will be reduced effective June 1, 2016.
