Dear Secretary Salas:

The New England Power Pool Participants Committee (“NEPOOL”) hereby submits a Revised Attachment 3 to the package that was filed jointly with ISO New England Inc. on February 6, 2006. That filing contains market improvements that were developed as Phase II of the Ancillary Services Market (“ASM”) project. The Revised Attachment relates solely to the background about the stakeholder process preceding the ASM filing and merely corrects a typographical error in the titles of the tables in that Attachment.

Attachment 3 tabulates the results of a number of votes by NEPOOL on the matters addressed in the filing. The vote tabulations in the Attachment are correct and were properly identified in the body of the transmittal letter at footnotes 32 and 33. As indicated in footnote 32, the tabulation of the Participants Committee votes at its meeting on October 14, 2005, is presented on pages 1-4 of Attachment 3; footnote 33 correctly identifies the vote tabulation on pages 5 through 8 of Attachment 3 as the votes of the Participants Committee at its January 6, 2006, meeting. When those tables were formatted for filing, however, the same heading was incorrectly applied to all of the tables, suggesting that all the votes were taken on January 6. The Revised Attachment 3 reflects the proper headings.
