**JOINT STATUS REPORT REGARDING AMENDED COMPLAINT
OF
THE MAINE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION AND
ISO NEW ENGLAND, INC.**

Pursuant to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“FERC” or “Commission”) September 20, 2007 Notice of Extension of Time, the Maine Public Utilities Commission (“MPUC”) and ISO New England Inc. (“ISO-NE”) respectfully request that the Commission continue to hold in abeyance the Amended Complaint filed in the above-captioned proceeding, including the answer by ISO-NE.

In the Amended Complaint submitted by the MPUC on September 17, 2007, the MPUC explained that one of the reasons for the extension may be addressed with the filing of the Amended Complaint and the contemporaneous filing of the Settlement Agreement in ER07-397-000, -001, and that the stakeholder process to address the cost allocation issues raised in the original Complaint and the Amended Complaint, which is the other basis for the extension, is still ongoing. For these reasons, the MPUC, with the concurrence of ISO-NE, requested that the extension of time granted with respect to the original Complaint remain in effect for the Amended Complaint, such that the MPUC and ISO-NE would file a status report on the Amended Complaint on or before October 16, 2007.

On September 20, 2007, the Commission issued its Notice of Extension of Time, granting the MPUC's request, and setting the date by which answers to the MPUC's Amended Complaint are due to October 16, 2007.

ISO-NE has committed to the stakeholders to state its position on the cost allocation issues raised by the Amended Complaint on or before October 30, 2007. The MPUC and ISO-NE respectfully request that the Commission further extend the date by which either answers will be due to be filed, or another status report by the MPUC and ISO-NE will be filed, to November 30, 2007. Granting the MPUC's and ISO-NE's request will give the New England Power Pool ("NEPOOL") Transmission Committee and Participants Committee time to consider the matter.

For these reasons, the MPUC and ISO-NE jointly request that the Commission continue to hold the instant Complaint proceeding in abeyance, including the requirement that ISO-NE submit an answer to the Complaint, until November 30, 2007, at which time either answers will be filed, or the MPUC and ISO-NE will submit another status report to the Commission.

Wherefore, for the foregoing reasons, the MPUC and ISO-NE jointly request that the Commission continue to hold in abeyance the Complaint filed in the above-captioned proceeding, including the answer by ISO-NE.
