Dear Mr. Douglass and Mr. Lombardi:

On March 13, 2015, you filed, on behalf of ISO New England Inc. (ISO-NE) and the New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Participants Committee, revisions to the ISO-NE Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff. You state that the changes include a new, replacement LMP Calculator¹ that will ensure that dispatch rates and real-time energy market prices are more closely aligned.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective May 27, 2015, as requested.

¹ The LMP Calculator is the part of ISO-NE's system dispatch software that calculates prices in the real-time energy market.

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The filing was noticed on March 13, 2015, with comments, interventions and protests due on or before April 3, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2014)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against ISO-NE or NEPOOL.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
