ISO New England Board Members Re-elected

Slate Composed of Current Board Members Abernathy, Brown, and Board Chair Shapiro

Holyoke, MA—September 17, 2015—ISO New England today announced that current Board members Kathleen Abernathy, Roberta Brown, and Board Chair Philip Shapiro have been re-elected to the ISO [Board of Directors](#), effective October 1, 2015.

As a Regional Transmission Organization, ISO New England elects its board members through a nominating process that involves representatives from the ISO New England Board of Directors, the New England Power Pool (NEPOOL), and the New England Conference of Public Utilities Commissioners. Candidates also receive the endorsement of the NEPOOL Participants Committee. This year's election represents the eleventh year of this collaborative selection process.

Kathleen Abernathy joined the Board in 2012. Roberta Brown joined in 2007, while Phil Shapiro joined in 2010 and was elected Chairman in 2014.

ISO New England Board members are subject to the company's code of conduct that includes a nonaffiliation provision, which means that no officer of the company can have a financial interest in any company participating in New England's wholesale markets.
