

Resource Operator OP-14 Training

Purpose

Resource Operator OP-14 Training (ROOT) satisfies the initial and continuing training requirements listed in OP-14 for designated entity (DE), demand-designated entity (DDE), and applicable lead market participants.

Specifically, this training is for personnel who perform any of these tasks:

- Communicating verbally with the ISO New England control room system operators
- Acknowledging or responding to verbal or electronic dispatch instructions
- Receiving and acknowledging Emergency Notification System (ENS) messages
- Performing redeclaration of generator, dispatchable asset related demand, alternative technology regulating resource, or continuous storage facility operational parameters or availability
- Performing resubmittal of demand-response resource operational parameters or availability

Personnel must complete ROOT *before* they perform any of the above-mentioned tasks to meet the **initial training** requirement.

Personnel must complete ROOT each subsequent year between the time that ROOT is updated and December 1st to meet the **continuing training** requirement.
