NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(August 30, 2019)

On January 18, 2019, ISO New England Inc. (ISO-NE) filed a motion requesting an extension of the July 1, 2019 deadline for filing the long-term fuel security mechanism ordered by the Commission on July 2, 2018.¹ On March 18, 2019, the Commission granted the motion and extended the deadline to October 15, 2019.² On July 31, 2019, the New England States Committee on Electricity filed a motion requesting an additional six-month extension of time to allow ISO-NE and the region to work through issues related to ISO-NE's proposed long-term fuel security mechanism. Several commenters support the motion.³ ISO-NE, New England Power Pool Participants Committee, Repsol Energy North America Corporation, and Verso Corporation neither support nor oppose the motion. New England Power Generators Association, Inc. opposes extending the filing date beyond December 20, 2019.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that an extension of time is granted up to and including April 15, 2020 for ISO-NE to file its long-term fuel security mechanism.
