**Subject:** Public Notification for Public Policy Requirements Submittals

Pursuant to Section 4A.1 of Attachment K of the ISO New England Open Access Transmission Tariff, the ISO is posting this notice indicating that members of the Planning Advisory Committee may, within no later than 45 days after the posting of this notice:

- Provide input to NESCOE, in accordance with Section 4A.1 of Attachment K, regarding state and federal Public Policy Requirements identified as driving transmission needs relating to the New England Transmission System, and regarding particular transmission needs driven by those Public Policy Requirements
- Provide input to the ISO, in accordance with Section 4A.1 of Attachment K, regarding local (e.g., municipal and county) Public Policy Requirements identified as driving transmission needs relating to the New England Transmission System, and regarding particular transmission needs driven by those Public Policy Requirements
