ISO New England Inc. ("ISO-NE") has reviewed this de-list bid pursuant to the ISO-NE Planning Procedure No. 10 – *Planning Procedure to Support the Forward Capacity Market* ("PP10") and has determined there is no local reliability need for this resource that would result in the rejection of the requested de-list bid.

As required in PP10, this finding was reviewed with the Reliability Committee at the August 2021 meeting, and ISO-NE received an advisory vote to support that the analyses for this de-list bid were performed in accordance with Section III.13.2.5.2.5 of the ISO-NE Transmission, Markets and Service Tariff ("ISO Tariff") and PP10, Section 7.

Pursuant to the ISO Tariff Section III.13.2.5.2.5.3, this resource will be retired from all New England Markets and all interconnection service for the resource will terminate effective June 1, 2025. If the resource wishes to retire before this date, it must meet the requirements set forth in Section III.13.2.5.2.5 of the ISO Tariff.
